


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1.1 GOALS

A candidate upon successfully qualifying in the M.S. Orthopaedics / diploma orthopaedics examinations should be able to

- 1. Diagnose the diseases and injuries of musculo skeletal system

1ST TERM

- 1. History taking & clinical examination of patients attending orthopaedics OPD & admitted in wards.
- 2. Plaster technique & removal of plaster cast.
- 3. Operation theatre discipline.

2nd TERM

- 1. Dressing, debridement & suturing of wounds.
- 2. Intra-articular injection techniques.

3rd TERM

- 1. Application of various traction (skin/skeletal)
- 2. Management of crush injury & compound fracture. (Primary Care)

<u>4th TERM</u>
Closed Reduction & K-wire fixation of fractures.

5th TERM

1. Open Reduction & fracture fixation of upper extremity.

6th TERM

- Open Reduction & internal fixation of lower extremity. 1.
- Assisting senior faculty for spine, hip replacement surgery & 2. deformity correction.
