Advanced Human Milk Bank on 4th Oct 2023 at 4.00PM.**

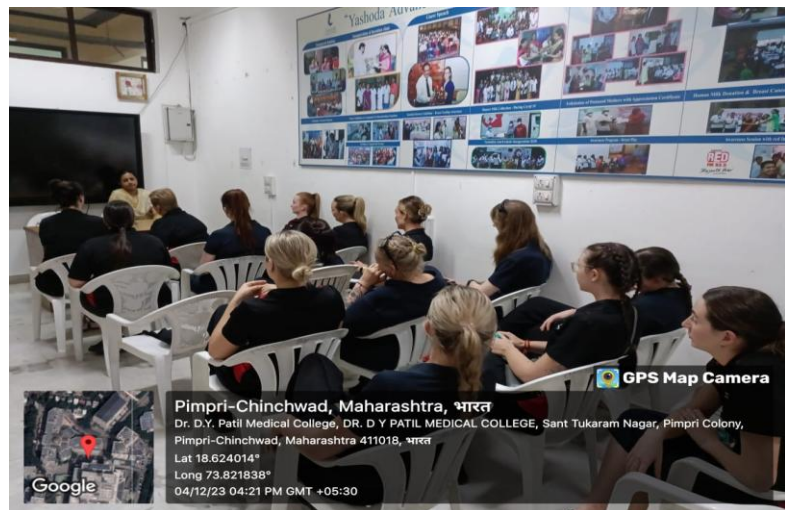
Fifteen students and three faculties from Tasmania University, Australia to “Yashoda” Advanced Human Milk Bank, at Dr. D.Y. Patil Medical College, Hospital and Research Centre, Pimpri, Pune on 4th of Dec 2023 at 4 PM.

Mrs. Dr. Shailaja Mane gave them an orientation of “Yashoda” Advanced Human Milk Bank. They were briefed about the donor and recipient statistics and different documents that are used. They also went through the different patient informative brochures and material.

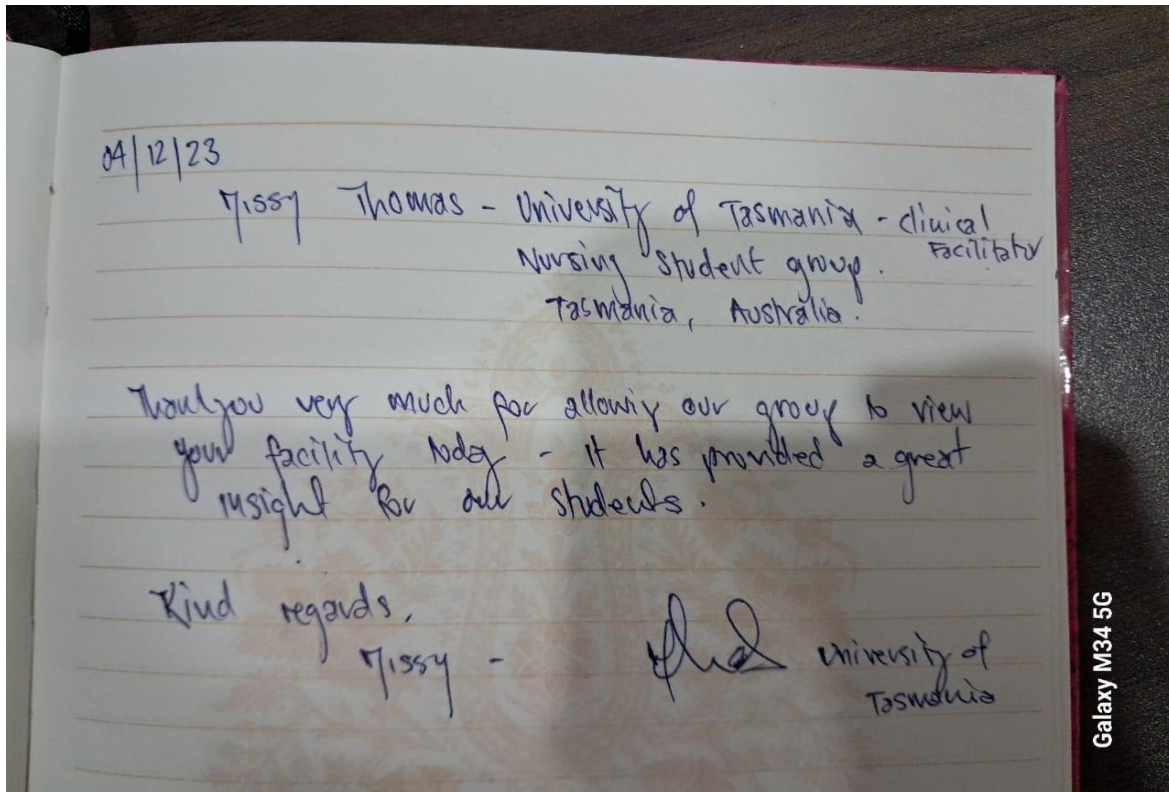


Mrs. Dr. Shailaja Mane explained to them the working of a Human Milk Bank and the various processes that are involved. She explained about Donor mother screening, importance of informed consent, hygiene protocols, milk collection and correct use of hospital-grade electric breast pumps. She also explained in detail about the milk storage guidelines, pasteurization process, milk analysis, laboratory screening and priority based safe dispensing of PDHM to needy babies.

The students were extremely pleased to see the spacious and comfortable 'Milk expression area for mothers'. They are see the first time human milk bank. They asked questions about number of mothers that benefit from the facility on a daily basis, whether any compensation is given to the donor mothers and volume of milk that the mothers are able to express with the hospital-grade electric pumps. Mrs. Dr. Shailaja Mane answered all these queries and emphasized on Milk donation being completely voluntary and consensual. Donor mothers are not compensated in any manner not forced in any way to donate their milk. They truly believe it to be a noble cause and willingly donate their precious milk. As a token of appreciation, they are given Certificates for their wonderful contribution.



The students were highly impressed with the setup and the huge volumes of milk that have been collected here and distributed to needy babies over last many years at “Yashoda” Advanced Human Milk Bank. They also found the concept of Milk Van and home collection to be unique and beneficial.
