

## 1. Fellowship in Geriatric Medicine

The Fellowship Programme shall be of one year with 240 teaching and working days / 2 semesters with the following distribution. The Programme shall have the contents of around 960 hours of Teaching, Learning (around 40 Credits).

360 hours of Practical/ Demonstration/Hands on experience/ Lab work 12 credits

360 hours of Field work/ Clinical Work/ Research Work 12 credits

150 hours of Teaching and learning Include lectures, flipped classroom, problem based learning.

360 hours of Field work/ Clinical Work/ Research Work Visit to old age homes Visit to physiotherapy centre One project based on geriatrics
