The Institute initially started with MBBS programme (U.G.) with an intake of 100 seats. The Institute has laterally expanded with 250 MBBS seats, 218 MD & MS (PG) seats, 22 M.Ch./D. M. (Superspeciality) seats, Ph. D. programmes in all medical specialities, Fellowship programmes in 31 subjects and certificate courses in 19 subjects, in a short span of 25 years.
