






#### SKILLS & SIMULATION LABORATORY

- The DPU Clinical Simulation & Skills Lab is situated on the 3rd Floor of the Hi-tech hospital building.
- It has briefing & debriefing Rooms, Demonstration Rooms, Standardized Patient Simulation Rooms plus a Simulated ICU Emergency Room, Task Training Rooms, Laparoscopy and Endoscopy, and Arthroscopy Stations.
- This has High Fidelity Computerized & manual Mannequins & also has models for U G, PG, and Superspeciality Training. It has High-speed Internet and Modern Audio-Visual teaching aids.
- This is utilized for Lectures, Audio-Video presentations & online teaching sessions of the Skills Lab. The Department uses the Clinical Simulation & Skills Lab for their teaching & learning needs & is open from Monday to Saturday.



# **DEPARTMENTAL MUSEUM**

The Museum houses a rich collection of over 150 specimens. All specimens available museum are from the cases operated in our institute and mounted in our department itself. We have also maintained a catalog that contains descriptions of all the surgical specimens. Undergraduate and postgraduate students periodically visit the museum for self-study.




