What Constitutes Ragging?

- ❑ Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following Acts with/without an Intent to derive a Sadistic pleasure or Showing off Power/Authority/Superiority By a Student over Fresher/any other Student-

- Any conduct by any Student or Students
either by words spoken or written or by act
which has the effect of teasing, treating or
handling with rudeness
a Fresher or any other Student

- Indulging in rowdy or indisciplined activities by any Student/Students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any Fresher or any other Student

- Asking any Student to do any act which such Student will not do in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the Physique or Psyche of such Fresher or any other Student

- Any act by a Senior Student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of a Fresher or any other Student
- Exploiting the services of a Fresher or any other Student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an Individual/Group of Students

- Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure or burden put on a Fresher or any other Student by Senior Student/s
- Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: stripping, sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, gestures, forcing obscene and lewd acts, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health of Fresher or any other Student

- Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, posts, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to Fresher or any other Student

- Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a Fresher/other Student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a Student over any Fresher or other Student

- Any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at Fresher or any other Student on the ground of colour, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, appearance, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, regional origins, nationality, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence or economic background

Preventive Measures

- List of Anti-Ragging Committee Members and Anti-Ragging Squad Members for year 2020-21 (with contact numbers working round the clock) uploaded on Websites of Dr. D. Y. Patil Medical College, Hospital and Research Centre, Pimpri, Pune and Dr. D. Y. Patil Vidyapeeth, Pune

- Banners/Posters of same list displayed at conspicuous Places in Institute like Lecture halls, Auditorium, Hospital, Library, Hostels, Canteen, etc.
- Posters about Prohibition of Ragging displayed at conspicuous Places in Institute
- Freshers lodged in separate Hostel Block with round the clock vigilance

- Undertaking about non-indulgence in Ragging taken from Students and their Parent/Guardian and submitted online on UGC website of Anti Ragging
- Possible Vulnerable points in Campus are identified, properly illuminated and round the clock Security watches provided

- Printed Leaflet for freshly admitted students detailing to whom they should Contact for Help and Guidance
- Sensitization programmes for Seniors
- Sensitization programmes for Freshers
- Joint Sensitization programmes for both Freshers and Seniors

- Frequent visits of Anti Ragging Squad and Hostel Vigilance Squad to College, Hospital, Hostels, Canteen and other vulnerable places at different timings
- Instructions to all Employee (Teaching and Non-Teaching) to immediately report the incidence/doubtful incidence of Ragging to appropriate Authorities

Action to be Taken by the Head of Institution

- ❑ On receipt of the recommendation of the Anti Ragging Squad or on receipt of any Information concerning any reported Incident of Ragging, the Head of Institution shall immediately determine if a case under the Penal Laws is made out and if so,

- Either on his Own or through a Member of Anti-Ragging Committee authorized by him in this behalf, proceed to file a First Information Report (FIR), within 24 hours of receipt of such information/recommendation, with the Police and Local Authorities, under the appropriate Penal Provisions

- Institution shall also continue with its Own Enquiry initiated under clause 9 of these Regulations & other measures without waiting for action on part of the police/local authorities & such remedial action shall be initiated & completed immediately, in no case later than a period of 7 days of reported occurrence of the incident of Ragging

Administrative Action in the Event of Ragging

- ❑ The Anti-Ragging Committee may, depending on the nature and gravity of Guilt, established by the Anti-Ragging Squad, award, to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments, namely-
 - Suspension from attending Classes and Academic Privileges

- Withholding/withdrawing Scholarship, Fellowship and other Benefits
- Debarring from appearing in any Test, Examination or other Evaluation process
- Withholding Results
- Debarring from representing Institution in any Regional, National or International Meet, Tournament, Youth Festival, etc.

- Suspension/Expulsion from the Hostel
- Rustication from the Institution for period ranging from One to Four Semesters
- Cancellation of admission
- Expulsion from the Institution and consequent Debarring from Admission to any other Institution for specified Period
