Detailed Explanations:

- 1) The RHTC (Rural Health Training Centre) under Department of Community Medicine provided free medical services during the Ashadhi Wari pilgrimage between 17th to 19th June 2025. This was a special effort to help the many devotees who walk during this important spiritual event.
- 2) The medical team worked 12 hours every day to make sure pilgrims could get help when they needed it. A mobile clinic was set up at the Alandi bus stand for immediate care. Interns were posted at different mobile health booths and at the local hospital to cover the whole area in coordination with the Rural hospital, Alandi. They treated common problems like fever, cold, cough, diarrhea, and myalgia.
- 3) Over the three days, a total of nearly 2500 people received outpatient care and 28 people were admitted for inpatient care for observation.
- 4) This helpful program was organized by the Department of Community Medicine, with support from the medical store. The medical team comprised of postgraduate students, interns and support staff. Their teamwork and dedication showed how healthcare can reach beyond just hospitals.

This effort kept thousands of pilgrims healthy and safe, showing a great example of public health services delivered with care and commitment.
