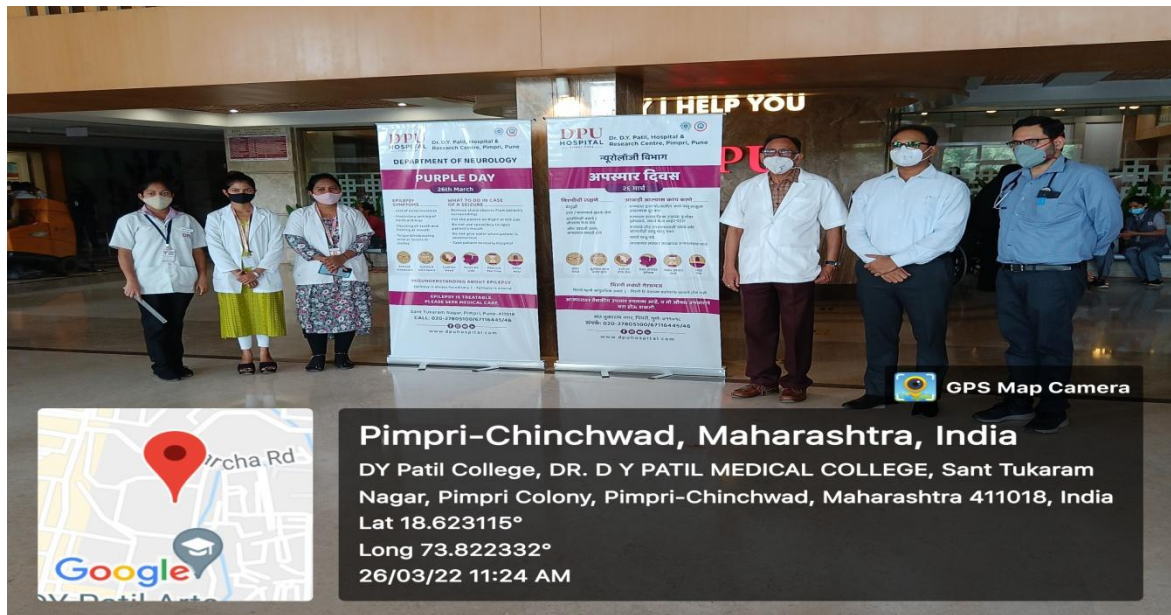


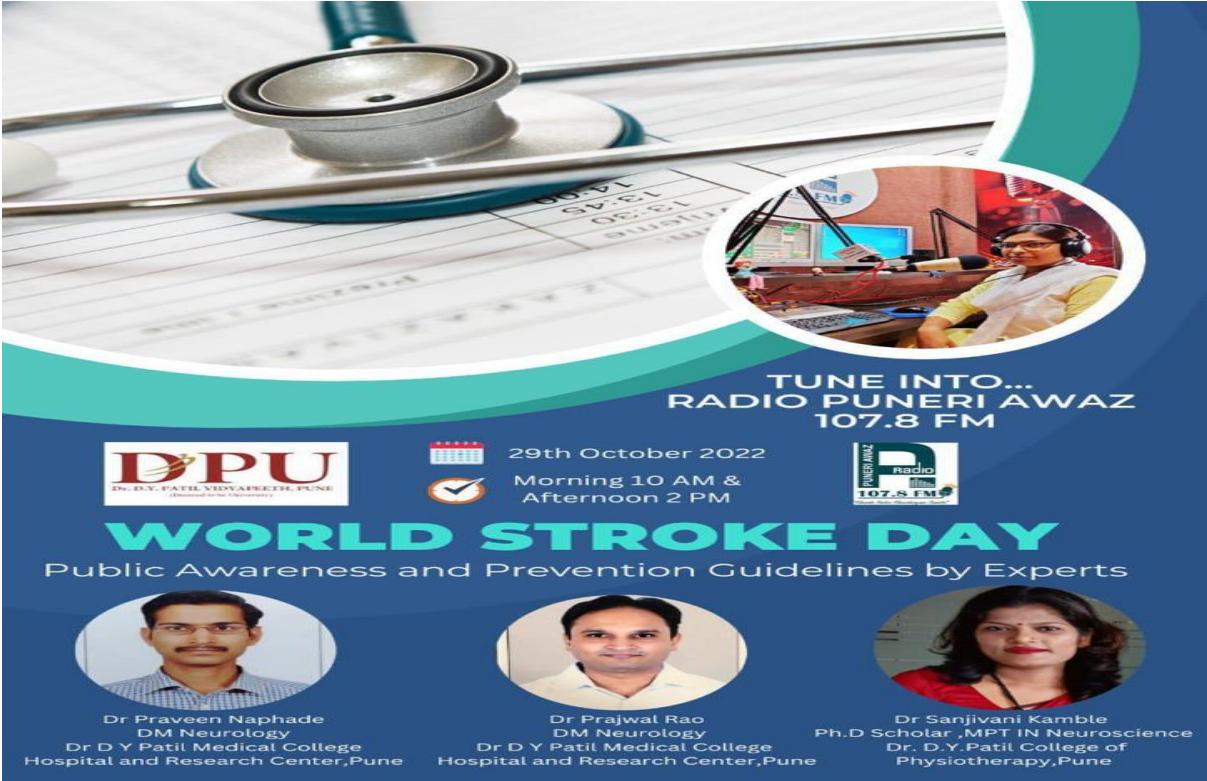
World Epilepsy Day 26th March 2022
