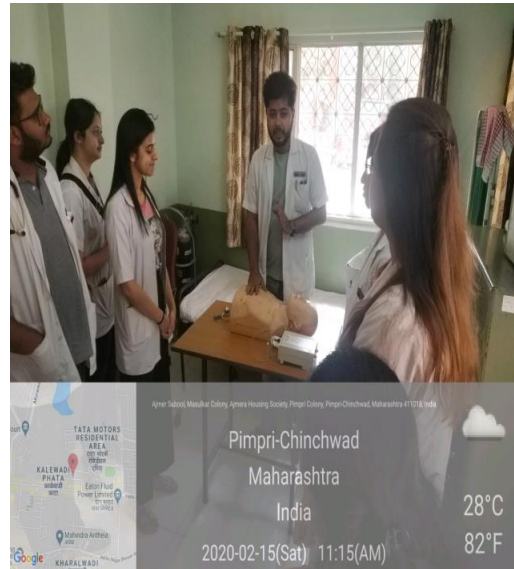

Date - 5th February 2020

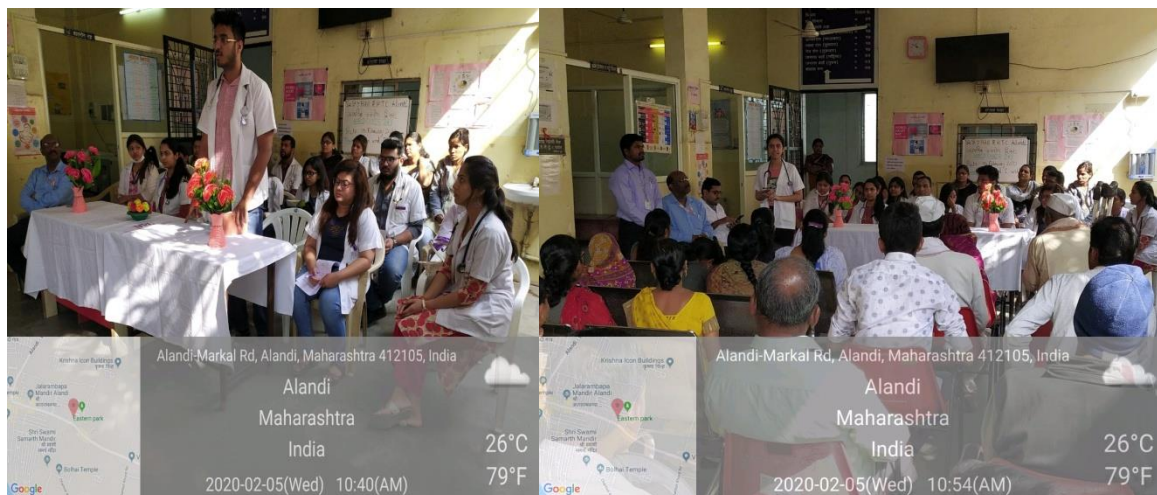
Place - RHTC

Health check up camp

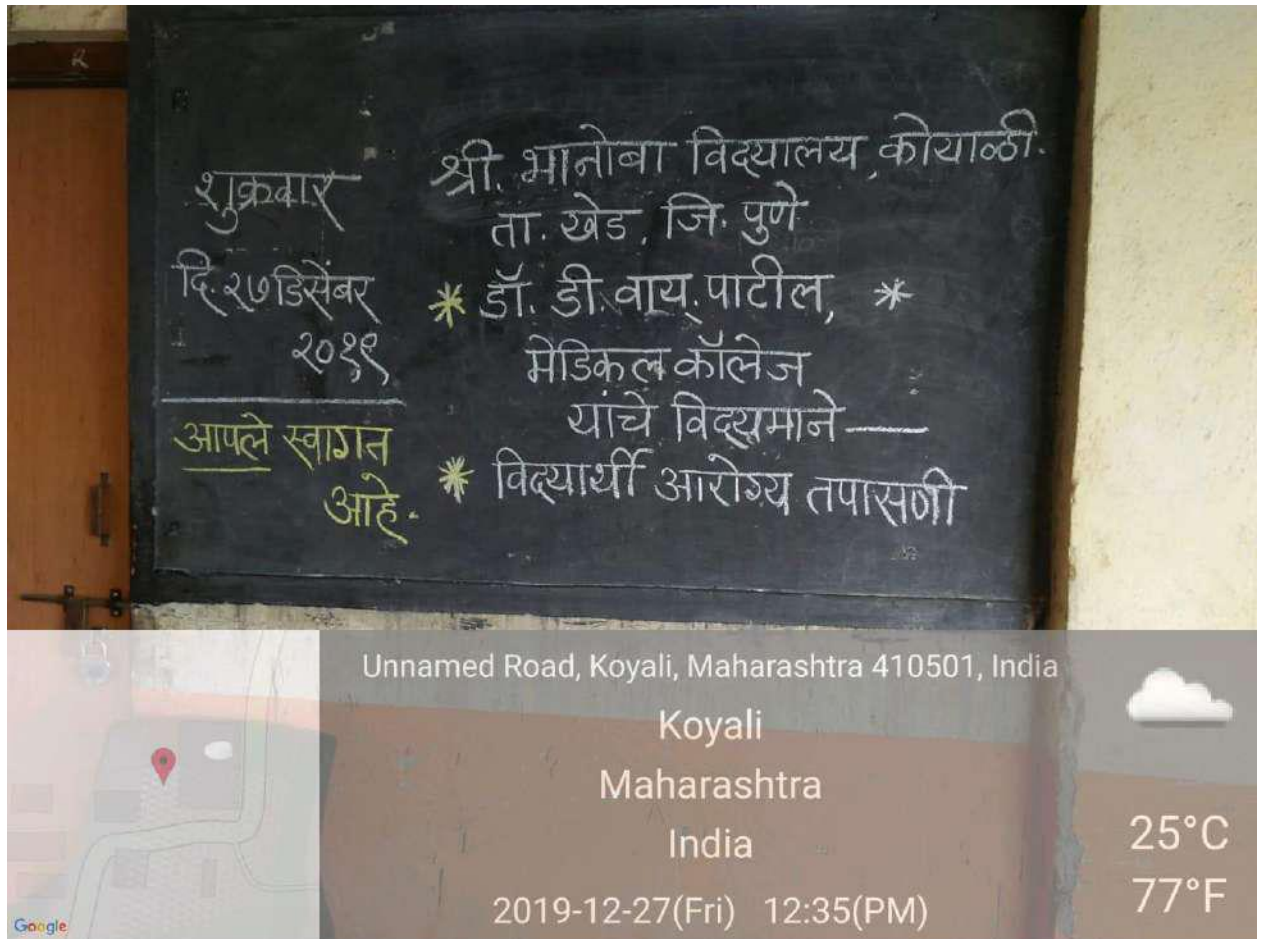

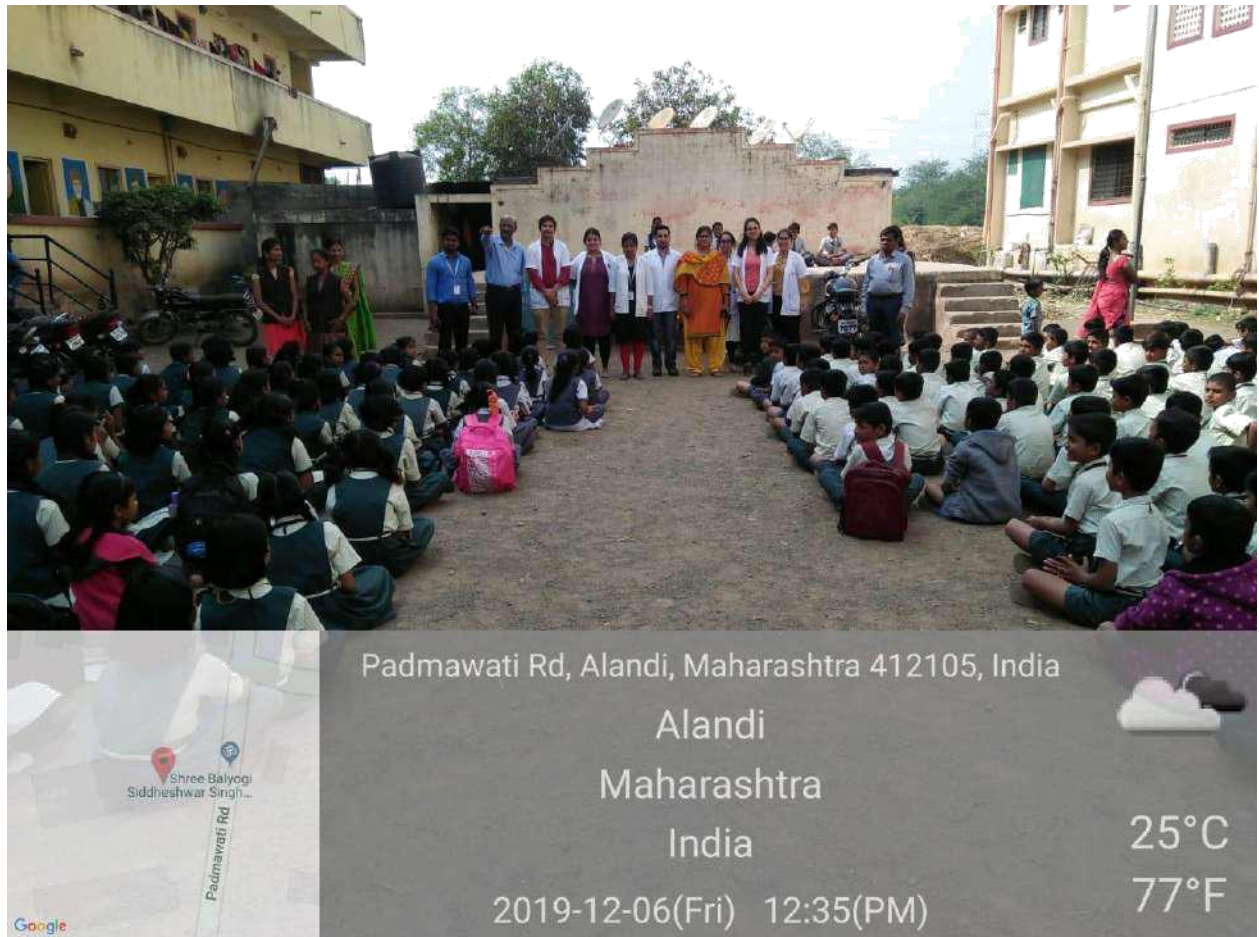

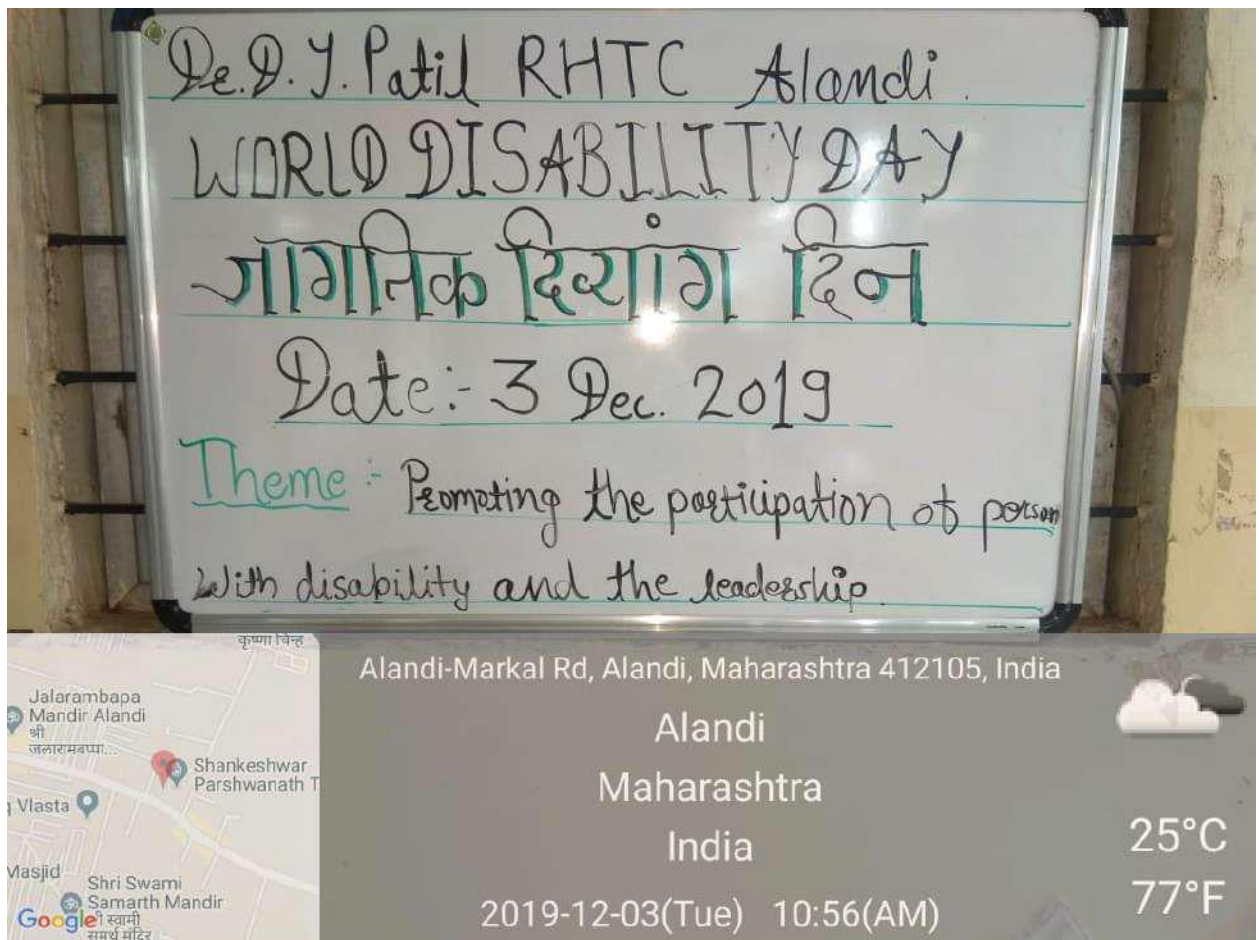
DESABILITY DAY

Place: RHTC

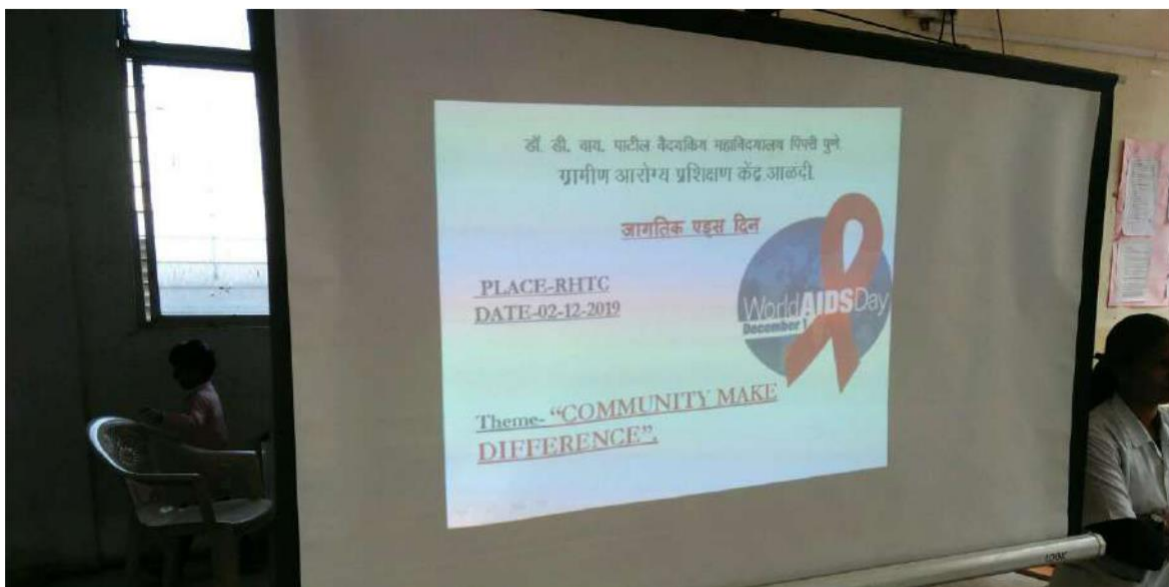
