
A Case of Advanced Keratoplasty

COMPLAINTS

 A 60 year old female came to the ophthalmology OPD with complaints of diminution of vision in RE associated with pain and redness since 2 years, following cataract surgery.

HISTORY OF PRESENTING ILLNESS

- Diminution of vision was in the RE 2 months following cataract surgery which was gradual in onset, progressive and <u>painful</u> in nature
- Pain was dull aching type, and continuous in nature and was associated with redness in the same eye
- There were no aggravating or relieving factors













Figure 1 Different types of corneal transplant procedures







E/O HYDROXYPROPYL METHYLCELLULOSE HS


IV INJ DEXAMETHASONE 6mg BD










POD3 OCULAR COHERENCE TOMOGRAPHY




Total Penetrating Keratoplasty vs DSEK
