# **GENERAL MEDICINE**

### 1. GOAL

The goal of teaching the postgraduate student in General Medicine is to impart such knowledge, skills and attitudes that will enable him / her to diagnose and manage common as well as uncommon medical diseases affecting the patients. The student at the end of the course should be able to act as a consultant in medicine and render medical care at a secondary or tertiary level. The student should also have acquired teaching abilities to teach undergraduates the subject of General Medicine. He/she should also be able to conduct clinical research in the field of General Medicine.

#### 2. OBJECTIVE

The teaching shall be designed to fulfill the following objectives:

### • Knowledge:

At the end of the course the student shall have adequate knowledge of –

- a) Clinical features, pathophysiology and investigative procedures of medical disorders as outlined in the syllabus to arrive at an optimum management plan for the patient.
- b) Drug therapy especially their dose, side effects, toxicity, indications, contraindications and interactions.
- c) Recent advance in the field of General Medicine.
- d) A brief history of medicine. Carrying out clinical research.

#### Skills

At the end of the course the student should be able to-

- a) Apply clinical skills of history taking and clinical examination to diagnose medical disorders and medical emergencies;
- b) Perform all bed side procedures and biopsies required for the diagnosis of the patient.
- c) Interpret X-Ray, ECG, CT & MRI scan and laboratory report findings.
- d) Amalyze the patients clinical and investigative data to discuss the diagnosis and differential diagnosis.
- e) To be able to formulate an optimum management plan for treatment, follow up and rehabilitation of the patient

#### • Attitude:

The candidate should develop the attitude required to be a consultant in medicine and be able to impart the same to junior colleagues. The student should have developed an attitude of scientific enquiry and be adept in conduction clinical trials and publishing a scientific paper.
